### Main Income:

- Total Fundraising Campaigns \$71.96 (Includes Square 1 Art)
- Total Program Fundraising \$976.83 (Includes Box Tops, E-Waste Recycling, Ice Bar Sale, Scrip, Spirit Wear Sales)



### Main Expenses:

- Total Payne Support \$3,058.15 (Includes Grade level Allocation, Principal's Fund, Staff Appreciation, Teacher's Classroom Reimbursement, Walk n Roll, Non-Budgeted Payne Support)
