- Reminder about the ways we assess students:
 - iReady Diagnostic system now being used at Payne. Through this new system, parents will get to see the scores during Parent Teacher Conference. Note: In most cases, iReady Diagnostic was given in August/September, so the teacher's report card will be the most up-to-date assessment about where your child is at with their learning
 - Fountas & Pinnell Reading Level: Student reads to the teacher and the teacher scores based on how they do, what mistakes they make, etc. They also assess comprehension of the text.
 - Plus the usual Classroom Formative & Summative Assessments
