- Vote to approve meeting minutes from April 28

 - Increased Grade-level allocations (also, note: there'll be an extra class a transitional kindergarten class - next year)
 - Total expenditure proposed: \$75,300 (note: this is based on expected fundraising; if we raise more money via things like the annual support drive, we will have more money to spend)

Principal's report

- Big thank-you for Staff Appreciation Week
- May 31 there will be a volunteer appreciation gathering, after Spirit Assembly
- RAFT truck was a success again one more visit (Tuesday) remaining for the year
- Also Tuesday: senior walk event will happen, where former Payne students who are graduating from high school will visit and have a parade
- Promethean Smart Boards and Carts are ordered for the Kindergarten classes delayed the order as Payne is hosting summer school, so they'll be arriving early August and will have them ready for Day 1 of the new school year
- Ideas for next year
 - Want to work on getting more volunteers. Note: We haven't had a spring fundraiser for the last couple of years because we didn't have volunteers to run it
 - Will be experimenting with moving from a Payne Panther newsletter every other week to a weekly email from the principal (where the content is in the email)
 - Planning Grade-level playdates after school for kids and parents to get to know each other, early in the fall
 - Bolstering Room Parent program, for better communications to parents in each classroom
 - Bring back "copy parent" volunteer roles and provide training
 - Parent Forum/Principal's Coffee every other month to gather informally and have coffee and snacks

 Also considering making a volunteer bulletin board in Room 8 and using the room for HSC meetings as well as a space for parents

Questions

- Will every school in the district have a transitional kindergarten (TK) class in the new school year?
 - Two schools will each have two TK classes. Payne will have 1 next year, 2 the year after that; potentially 3 the year after that.
 - o Will also be increasing extended care space
 - Kindergarten will go to full days in 2024/25
- Feedback: Moreland district LCAP survey has so many acronyms and programs, it's hard to answer the questions without knowing what they all are
 - Also very long surveys with repeated questions
